

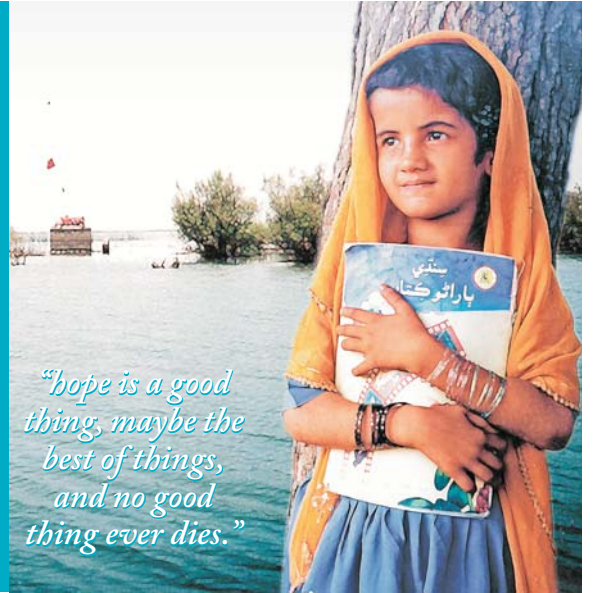

The recent unprecedented floods in Pakistan have left many impoverished. Thousands of people have been directly affected and displaced and many schools have been damaged as well. Since schools play a critical role during and after disasters in many contexts, the Sindh Education Foundation's work with the communities is enhanced even more. Schools can act as havens for whole communities; disseminate information on hazards and mitigation through participatory measures and help people particularly children deal with distress and trauma caused by disasters.

Key Interventions:

SEF has initiated a series of relief efforts through establishing camps at various sites as well as launching the Emergency Education Program for children and adults in the first phase. The second phase will concentrate on school revival.

→ Phase 1:

◆ Relief Work

Food, water, shelter & basic health services

◆ Emergency Education Program for children & adults at Relief Camps across Sindh

Child-friendly spaces; Educational aids; Activity materials; Adult education; First-aid training; Skill development

→ Phase 2:

◆ School Revival

Identifying, repairing and rebuilding schools
